



### Library

There is a collection of more than 1015 titles and 5000 volumes of assorted and exhaustive textbooks and reference books in the Library. The Library subscribes to more than 150 international journals annually and there is a good collection of back volumes of these journals. The Library's collection also comprises textbooks, magazines and scientific journals on various subjects of general and popular interest as well. The Library provides well equipped, comprehensive and extensive online and offline databases with the utilization of its digital library which can be accessed through its special Internet enabled section. It has separate reading rooms. Students are encouraged to spend time in the library to improve their understanding and knowledge.

### Hostel

The College campus has seven spacious, well-designed and properly furnished separate hostels for boys and girls, including different ones for Undergraduate and Postgraduate students. Each hostel room has an attached bath and toilet. Each hostel has separate common rooms with color television with DTH, and facilities for indoor games where students can relax after exhaustive hours of study. Faculty and staff members from outside of Udaipur can also reside in the hostels.



### Transport Facility

The College has its own fleet of buses, which punctually bring students from different corners of the city to the College at a nominal cost. At present it owns five buses, which are likely to be increased as per requirements.

### Cafeteria

The modern Cafeteria on the campus provides hygienic and mouth-watering delicacies and different snacks to the students. Special dishes are served on special occasions.

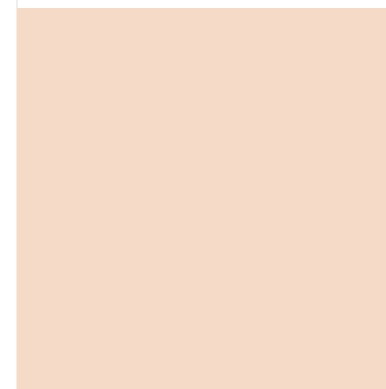

# Pacific Dental College & Hospital

The College and Hospital are spread over a 1.3 lakh sq.ft. area that accommodates the administration offices, nine dental departments, four lecture theatres (120 seats per theatre) and a library. The nine departments are equipped with separate under-graduate and post-graduate sections, fully equipped with seminar rooms and are serviced with more than 325 dental chairs with all required attachments. The library is equipped with more than 5000 books, with more being added in every academic year. It subscribes to more than 150 international journals on oral and dental healthcare. A

separate section with Internet connectivity allows faculty and students to access to the subscribed on-line medical journals. There is a separate section on the campus with an area of 25,000 sq.ft. for the Department of Basic Sciences. The campus also includes hostels for students with separate buildings for undergraduate and graduate students.

### Admission Procedure

#### a. Eligibility for BDS Program:

No candidate shall be allowed admission to the dental curriculum of first year Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) course unless they fulfil the following criteria:

1. He/She shall be a minimum age of 17 years on, or before 31<sup>st</sup> December, of the year of admission to the BDS course.
2. He/She must have passed 10+2 Examination with minimum 50% marks in Physics-Chemistry-Biology (PCB) and passed in English subject.

#### Duration of the Course:

The undergraduate dental training program leading to BDS degree shall be of 4 years with 240 teaching days in each academic year. During this period, the student shall be required to be engaged in full-time academics.
